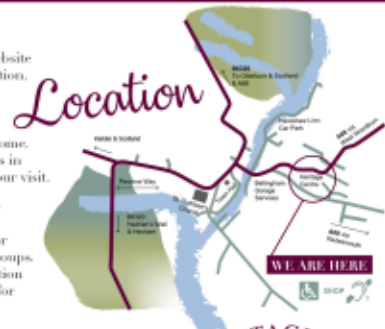

Revel in the romance of the age of steam in our railwayana exhibition, acclaimed by railway enthusiasts, then see what's survived of our special station.

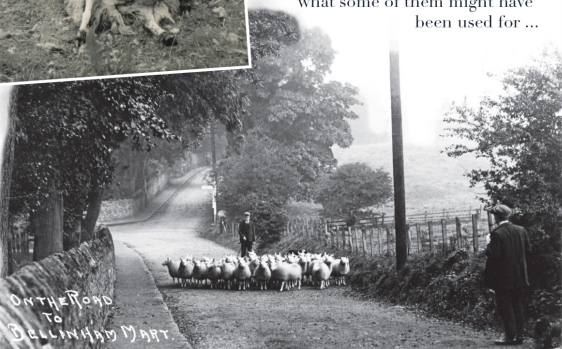


Working Lives
